



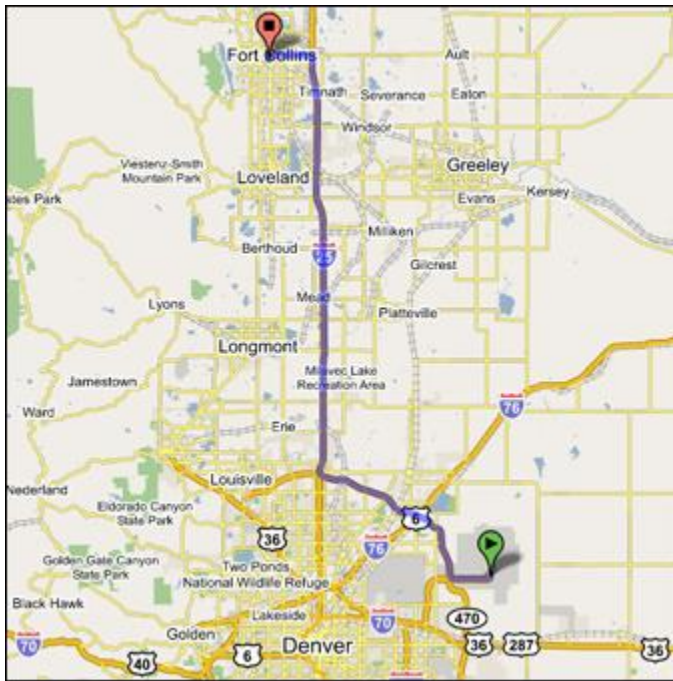

## *Emcon 2009 Directions and Parking*

### Location(s) & Driving Directions

#### Traveling from Denver International Airport



Fort Collins is located 65 miles north of Denver International Airport. There are several car rental agencies located at Denver International Airport.

- Take Pena Boulevard to I-70 west, to I-25 north, and follow directions to the Admissions Welcome Center provided above.  
OR
- Take Pena Boulevard to E-470 Toll Road north, to I-25 north, and follow directions to campus provided below.

Shuttle service to Fort Collins can be arranged by contacting Shamrock Airport Express at (970) 482-0505.

## University Welcome Center

- Exit I-25 at Prospect Road (Exit 268).
- Travel west on Prospect Road approximately 4 miles to College Avenue.
- Turn right (north) onto College Avenue.
- Continue approximately 0.7 miles and turn left (west) onto Laurel Street.
- Travel west on Laurel Street to Howes Street/Oval Drive.
- Turn left (south) onto Oval Drive. The road will bear right as a one way street. The Admissions Welcome Center, located in Ammons Hall, is the second building on the right.
- **Parking permits** - The lots surrounding the center are zoned and all spaces (other than short term loading zones) require a a Visitor Parking Permit (available at the reception desk in the Admissions Welcome Center) from 7:30am-4:00 pm Monday through Friday, except for University Holidays.
- **Nearby parking lots** - To access the parking lots near the center, take the first right-hand turn (about 100 feet after you bear right onto the Oval), into a small "A" parking strip. Proceed west into the larger parking lot southwest of Ammons Hall. If that lot is full, proceed further west into the next parking lot.

Location and Parking

Parking for events at the University Center for the Arts is available in the CSU parking lot on the west side of College Avenue which can be reached by entrances on Pitkin or Lake Streets.

A short stroll through the College Avenue underpass brings you through the Annual Trial Gardens to the University Center for the Arts at 1400 Remington Street.

## Lory Student Center (LSC)

**All presentations from Wednesday to Friday will take place at LSC.**

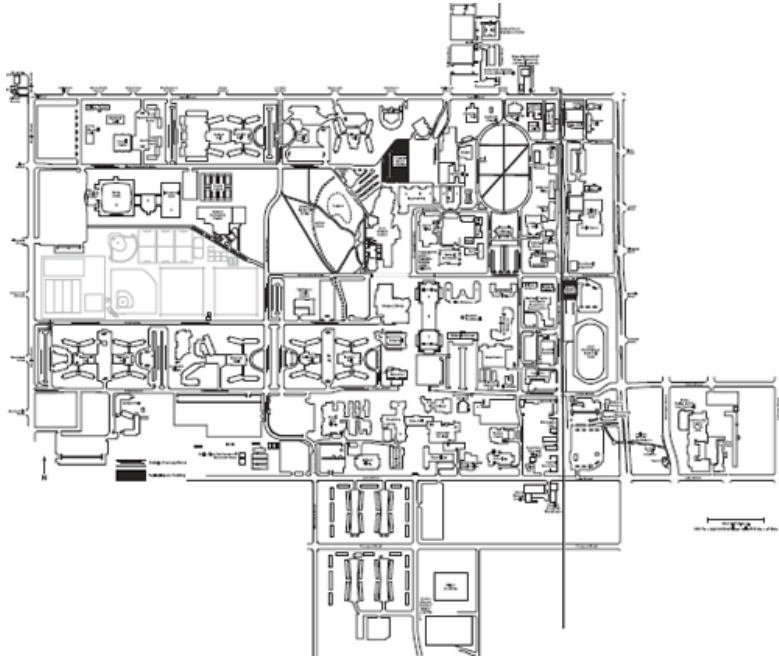
- From Interstate 25, exit at Prospect Road (#268).
- Travel west on Prospect approximately 4 miles to College Avenue (passing major intersections at Timberline Road and Lemay Avenue).
- At College Avenue, turn right (north).
- Continue north approximately three-quarters of a mile to Laurel Street, turn left (west), and travel west three-quarters of a mile to Meldrum Street (the second stop light), and turn left into the Lory Student Center parking lot.
- **Parking at a meter** - The Lory Student Center parking lot includes metered spaces that are enforced from 7:30a.m to 4:00pm., Monday through Friday, except for University Holidays and semester breaks. Visitor permits are not valid at meters during enforced hours - the posted fee must be paid during all enforced hours.
- **"A" zone parking** - The "A" zone spaces require a permit to park from 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday (except for specially signed portions of "A" zones which are enforced until 7:00p.m.), except for University Holidays and semester breaks.
